

under Section 94(4)(b) thereof, in directing that the Motion is admissible under Order 27(2) and (3) of the Standing Orders of the National Parliament (“Standing Orders”);

2. a declaration that the Motion contravenes the requirements of paragraphs (a), (b), (e), (g) and (i) of Order 27(3) of the Standing Orders and is therefore inadmissible;
3. a declaration that the proceedings foreshadowed by the Motion involve the reconsideration of specific questions on which Parliament has already taken decisions during its current and preceding meetings and contravene:
 - (a) Order 36(3); and
 - (b) Order 27(3)(a) and (g)of the Standing Orders;
4. such further or other relief as the Court thinks fit;
5. costs.
